New Jersey Institutions

Grounds for Sculpture

- To access free general admission for **J&J Current & Retired Employees and one guest (also valid for Ethicon or Janssen Employees)** use code **J&J2021** and [register here](#).

Liberty Science Center

- The LSC offers **free general admission** to J&J employees, **plus one additional guest**.
- In order to access these benefits, employees must bring their work ID to the ticket counter upon arrival. You do not need to reserve tickets in advance or book through the Corporate Art Department. This includes admission to the Jennifer Chalsty Planetarium and the Joseph D. Williams 3D Theatre.
- The LSC also offers a 10% discount off the purchase of a Family Membership.

New York Institutions

The Metropolitan Museum of Art

- Timed entry is currently in effect at The Met. **All visitors must reserve a time to visit prior to arrival at the Museum.** [Click here](#) to make a reservation
- Select the date and time of your visit
- Enter the number of people in your party
- Add to Cart and check out
- Bring your work ID with you to the museum to get your tickets at the counter
- **Note that your J&J ID allows admission for you and 1 guest.** NY residents as well as NY, NJ, CT students also get pay what you wish admission
- Note also, that certain exhibitions (ex. *Fashion and Time*) require an additional timed reservation that you can make upon arrival.

Whitney Museum of American Art

- Complimentary employee tickets must be pre-booked through the [Corporate Membership Ticketing](#) page.
- Each Johnson & Johnson employee will enter the unique promotional code **Johnson2** to receive **up to 2 complimentary tickets**.
- Upon booking confirmation, employee tickets will be sent via email with a barcode that will be scanned upon entry to the Museum.
- Employees will be asked to show their company ID or Business Card upon arrival – guests should arrive 10 minutes prior to their entrance time.
- Please note that the Whitney is operating at a significantly reduced capacity, and same-day tickets may be extremely limited.

- You'll see that enhanced precautions are being taken for your health and well-being. Prepare for your next visit by reviewing their [updated policies](#) put in place to make your visit as safe and stress-free as possible.

Museum of Modern Art

- Corporate Members are not required to reserve tickets. Upon arrival present your work ID or other proof of employment at the ticket desk.
- You should be able to get passes for yourself and up to 4 guests at the cost of \$5 per guest.

Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum

- To access free admission, [click here](#) and select date and time of visit.
- Select “Corporate Member Employee” as your ticket type.
- Click “apply discount code” and input promo code ‘**JNJ148**’ at checkout.
- Up to 4 tickets total will be discounted. Please note that employees will be required to display proof of employment when they arrive at the museum. Proof of employment can include a photo corporate ID, business card + photo ID, or paystub + photo ID.

American Museum of Natural History

- Select number of visitors (J&J employees may reserve up to 6 complimentary tickets), your date and time.
- Proceed to checkout, no code is necessary
- Upon arrival at the Rose Center Entrance (81st btw Columbus and Central Park West) head to the membership desk with your Work ID and a printed or digital version of your ticket.

Cooper Hewitt, Smithsonian Design Museum (opening June 10)

- Choose a date from the calendar.
- Select a time slot, quantity and click Add to Cart button.
- Cooper Hewitt, Smithsonian Design Museum's hours of operation are currently Thursday through Monday, 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Tickets are available up to two weeks in advance. Tickets are released each day for time slots two weeks out. Members receive priority access to tickets.
